Workshop built: Cherry with cedar soundboard, Ebony fretboard, Abalone dots and Planet Wave self-trimming machines: \$500

Workshop built: Walnut body with spruce soundboard, Ebony fretboard, pearl dots and Planet Wave self-trimming machines \$600.

Modern Mountain Dulcimer Appalachian Model - Walnut body, resonator back, redwood and spruce soundboards, Ebony fretboard, pearl dots and Planet Wave self-trimming machines. \$750 This is an heirloom level dulcimer.
